Part-Time Student Application

- OTC Admissions Application
- Proof of English Proficiency by one of the following:
 - Minimum TOEFL score of 61
 - Minimum IELTS score of 5
 - Successful completion of 15 credit hours or more from a U.S. college or university with a 2.25 GPA
- Current copy of academic transcripts from the institution you are attending
- A Part-Time Student Coordination form completed with your International Student Services office at your current school. (form on OTC website)
- Copy of F-1 visa and I-20 showing that the student will be “in status” through the end of the semester in which the student is registering.
