- 1. Apply for admission to Ozarks Technical Community College at <u>www.otc.edu</u> .
- Submit scholarship application & supporting documentation t: Ozarks Technical Community College, ATTN: Financial Aid Office/Scholarships; 1001 E. Chestnut Expwy; Springfield, MO 65802 by posted deadline for Fall and Spring semesters.
- 3. If you are applying for the Ambassador and/or the FGCS Scholarship, you must complete the application specifically designated for the related scholarship.
- 4. Have your official high school and/or college transcripts on file at OTC with rank, grade point average, and ACT scores.
- 5. All scholarship recipients will be notified by mail of any awards. Allow six (6) to eight (8) weeks for notification of awards.
- 6. Does not provide cash refund of scholarship. Scholarship is tuition waiver only and is not applied to the cost of books. Scholarship is nontransferable & may affect eligibility for other financial assistance.
- 7. Unless otherwise noted: 1) scholarships will pro-rate for less than full-time enrollment 2) scholarships are renewable for third and fourth semesters to students who maintain a cumulative 2.75 grade point average or higher in their coursework at OTC.
- 8. Cessation of enrollment will cause a loss of scholarship.
- 9. OTC Institutional Scholarships are not available for the summer term.
